

**NOTICE  
TULLYTOWN BOROUGH**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Tullytown, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, during its regular meeting to be held at 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 3, 2015 in the Borough Municipal Building, 578 Main Street, Tullytown, Pennsylvania, will consider the enactment and the Mayor will consider the approval, of an Ordinance; namely,

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL PERSONS, PARTNERSHIPS,  
BUSINESSES, AND CORPORATIONS TO OBTAIN A PERMIT FOR  
ANY CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH  
PERMITS; SETTING FORTH CERTAIN MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW  
CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT WITHIN AREAS OF THE BOROUGH OF  
TULLYTOWN WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO FLOODING; AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES  
FOR ANY PERSONS WHO FAIL, OR REFUSE TO COMPLY WITH, THE REQUIREMENTS  
OR PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE**

The proposed ordinance establishes procedures for construction or development within the Borough of Tullytown, and the requirement for a permit to be obtained from the Floodplain Administrator. Certain limitations or prohibitions on development or construction may exist depending on the location of the property for which a permit is requested within documented floodplains. Passage of the ordinance by the Borough of Tullytown is required for participation of the municipality and its citizens in the national flood insurance program.

A copy of the full-proposed text of the Ordinance may be examined at the Borough Offices in the Municipal Building, 578 Main Street, Tullytown, Pennsylvania and at the offices of the Bucks County Courier Times on business days from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. An attested copy of the proposed Ordinance has been filed in the Bucks County Law Library on the first floor of the Bucks County Courthouse, Main and Court Streets, Doylestown, Pennsylvania.
