NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF A PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION APPROVED WORK PLAN FOR BASELINE REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION The Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act (Act 2) requires that a Notice of Intent to Remediate (NIR) be provided to the municipality in which the site is located. Act 2 also provides that when a site is a Special Industrial Area or is being remediated to a Site-specific Standard, the municipality is afforded a 30-day comment period. The municipality has requested that a public involvement plan be initiated for the subject site which is identified as a 30.60-acre parcel of land located at 66 Levittown Parkway, Tullytown Borough, Bucks County, Pennsylvania (subject site). In accordance with the provisions of the Act, we are formally notifying you of our intent to remediate the subject site and the availability of a plan for review. A copy of the Notice of Intent to Remediate, which has been sent to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and was published on August 17, 2017. This notice will be published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin, and a summary of the notice has appeared in a local newspaper. Publication of this notice in a local newspaper initiates the 30-day public document review period. The plan/report is available for your review between January 5 and February 5, 2018 at the following locations; * Bucks County Free Library at 7311 New Falls Rd, Levittown, PA 19055; * Tullytown Borough at 500 Main Street, Tullytown, PA 19007; and * The Redevelopment Authority of the County of Bucks at 216 Pond Street, Bristol, PA 19007.
