TULLYTOWN BOROUGH MS4 POLLUTANT REDUCTION PLAN

The Tullytown Borough Council will accept comments from the public beginning on April 2, 2018 and extending through May 2, 2018 associated with the updated Borough's Pollutant Reduction Plan as required by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection as a component of the Borough's PAG-13 National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit for Stormwater Discharges from Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s). The updated Pollutant Reduction Plan outlines in general terms the Borough's 5-year plan between 2018 and 2023 to reduce sediment loadings from the MS4 stormwater discharges to Martins Creek. The updated Pollutant Reduction Plan will be available for public review Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30 am to 4:30 pm at the Municipal Offices of Tullytown Borough located at 500 Main Street, Tullytown, PA 19007. The updated Pollutant Reduction Plan is also available for public review on the Borough's website: www.tullytownborough.com. Comments may be provided in writing and delivered in person or via email or regular mail and addressed to Alison Smith, Borough Coordinator, Tullytown Borough.
