NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Tullytown Borough Council will meet at the Tullytown Borough Building, located at 500 Main Street, Tullytown, PA on Tuesday, February 5, 2019, at 7:00 p.m., and will, at that time, hold a public hearing to inform and obtain public comment prior to taking any action, and if appropriate after the public hearing to vote to adopt, an ordinance amending Article I, Mercantile Tax, and Article IV, Business Privilege Tax, of the Taxation Chapter (Chapter 158) of the Code of Ordinances of Tullytown Borough, as amended. The ordinance amends the Definition section of Article IV to revise the definition of the phrase "temporary, seasonal or itinerant business" in the business privilege tax article. The ordinance further changes the deadline to April 30 of each calendar year by which initial and annual mercantile tax and business privilege tax returns and remittances must be made.

Upon consideration of public comments and conclusion of the public hearing, the Tullytown Borough Council may act to adopt the ordinance described above at its regularly scheduled public meeting immediately following the hearing or at another public meeting held thereafter.
